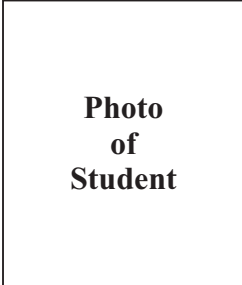

## GENERAL ETHOS

1. The students should carry their school diary daily along with all the text books and note books required for the day.
2. Photo of student in winter school uniform should be pasted in personal data and it should be duly signed by parents.
3. Students should come to the school regularly and on time. Late comers will be sent back.  
**No student will be allowed after 8.10 a.m.**
4. Students must attend morning assembly without fail.
5. Students are expected to respect the school property. No student should damage any school furniture, windowpane, black boards etc. Damage of any kind will be borne by the student concerned and fine shall also be imposed.
6. Students must keep their classroom/school campus/building neat. Scribbling on walls and desks is strictly prohibited.
8. **The Photograph of the student will not be attested by the Principal if it is not in proper school uniform.**
9. An absentee must, on return to school, produce an application signed by parents addressed to the Principal showing the cause of absence. (Format available in the school Almanac itself).
10. Attendance is compulsory on the first day of reopening of the school after vacations and on all school programmes.
11. **It is compulsory for all students to have minimum 75% attendance.**
12. Students are not allowed :
  - a. To wear or display tatoos.
  - b. To colour the hair.
  - c. To wear any jewellery (lockets, ear rings etc.) and fancy hair bands in the school.
  - d. Boys are not allowed to pierce their ears or wear earrings.
  - e. To bring anything to distribute among the students on the occasion of their birthday.
  - f. Cellphone or any music system if brought, shall be confiscated and returned after session end.
13. Only the students of classes (VI to XII) can come to school by bicycle and wear wrist watch.
14. **A student has to come in proper school uniform, even on his/her birthday.**
15. The issue of fee collection is between Parents and School and the student is not involved. It is the school's policy not to take fee issues with the students.
16. If a student is going out of school for some activity/excursion/competition during school hours or before and after the school hours, a consent letter from parents is compulsorily required otherwise the child shall not be allowed to participate.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

**Every student must come in the prescribed school uniform including I-Card.**

### **BOYS**

**SUMMER:** Half sleeves Sky Blue Shirt with Turquoise Blue Half pants (PP to V) or Trouser (VI to XII) along with properly polished Black leather shoes and school socks.

**WINTER:** White full sleeves shirt with Grey trousers, Black leather shoes, with grey woolen socks with sky blue strips (RPS embroidered), Prescribed Turquoise Blue V neck pullover with blazer for classes IV to XII, blue jacket with hood for classes PP - III.

### **GIRLS (PP-V)**

**SUMMER :** Half sleeves Sky Blue Shirt with Turquoise Blue divided Skirt along with properly polished leather Black shoes with school socks.

**WINTER :** White full sleeves shirt with Grey Pants Black leather shoes, grey woolen socks with sky blue strips (RPS embroidered), Prescribed Turquoise Blue V neck pullover with blazer for classes IV to XII, blue jacket with hood.

### **GIRLS (VI-XII)**

**SUMMER & WINTER :** A specially designed Salwar Kameez suit along with black leather shoes and school socks with sky blue stripes (RPS embroidered)

**ACCESSORIES :** Blue hair band/Ribbon for the girls. Sky Blue Patka for the Sikh boys in all seasons.

### **SATURDAY (HOUSE MEETING DAY)**

**BOYS & GIRLS (I TO XII) :** House T-shirt with Grey sports lower with sports shoes and white striped school socks.

### **FOR GIRLS:**

1. Hair should be neat, tidy and tied up in single or double braid.
2. Length of kameez should be knee length.

### **FOR BOYS:**

1. No spiky or outlandish hair styles.
2. The shirt should be neatly tucked and school pant should not be tapered.
3. School shirt should not be body fit.

**PTM :**

Both parents, please ensure to takeout time on Parent - Teacher Meeting Day and meet all the subject teachers, activity teacher and house master to discuss your ward's performance and progress. Your child is unique so we refrain you from making comparison of your ward with another child, even your own. If you still have some doubt or queries left unanswered due to time constraint, you are welcome to seek a personal appointment through reception to meet the specific teacher. We will be glad to assist you. **Your active participation is desirable to build a confident child.**

**ATTENDANCE :**

**75% attendance in an academic session is compulsory** for promotion to next class and for appearing in examination. It is parent's responsibility to see that their ward is regular and punctual to school.

**LEAVE :**

Half day and short leave is not permissible. Prior written permission for a long leave stating the reasons should be taken. Any leave must be followed by a written application. Medical leave application must accompany a medical certificate issued by a qualified Doctor alongwith a fitness certificate for joining back the school.

**BIRTHDAY :**

**Students are not allowed to come in Civil dress on their birthdays and distribute anything in their class. Parents are encouraged to gift new school uniform, books, stationery on birthdays/festivals.**

**LUNCH :**

It is necessary for a child to bring his/her lunch box in the morning itself. Handing over lunch during recess will not be appreciated. Please send one seasonal fruit to supplement his/her nutritious needs.

**HOUSE ACTIVITIES :**

Encourage your ward to participate in various house activities and meet the house master to tap his/her hidden talent.

**FEE DEPOSITION :**

Timely fee deposition is parents' responsibility. **Fee should be paid by 7th of every month.** Any reminder in this regard should be treated as urgent. Parents are advised to contact Accounts Section for deposition / clarification as name of the defaulters will be struck off at the end of the month unless a prior written application is submitted in this regard to the class teacher and permission is sought by the Principal. Late fee is applicable.



## **WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL TRANSPORT**

One month notice in writing or one month's bus fee in lieu of is required for withdrawal of bus facility. No student is allowed withdrawal of the transport facility in the last quarter unless there is a change of residence.

### **School Leaving Procedure:**

1. The parent should fill a School Leaving Form and clear all the dues.
2. They should submit the student's photograph in proper school uniform.

### **OUTSTATION TRIPS:**

For the all round development of the students, the school organises trips and activities for which the money is specifically collected through cheques. Please note the following conditions:

- (i) Once the cheque is submitted and reservation is made, only 50% of the amount be refunded.
- (ii) In case of a refusal sent 10 days before the journey date no refund will be given.
- (iii) Students should be in school uniform during the entire period of the excursion. (Unless otherwise stated).

**In case of any change in the Address, Mobile Number please inform the school immediately in writing to avoid any inconvenience.**

Students are expected to strictly comply with following rules:

**Respect for the Institution**

- A. Keep the buildings, class rooms, corridors and ground clean and in good condition.
- B. Don't cause destruction, defacement or damage to the school property. The student / students found guilty of any such offence will be penalized
- C. Refrain from leaving campus at any time during the school day unless authorized.

**Respect for Learning**

- A. Comply with all school rules and conduct yourself in an orderly manner.
- B. Be punctual and regular to school. 75% attendance is compulsory in an academic session. Students coming late will be sent back.
- C. Complete class work and homework assignments on time.
- D. Carrying objectionable material during exams will be considered a punishable offence.
- E. Using unfair means during exams is strictly prohibited and liable for serious action.
- F. Take care of the school library books.
- G. Attend the morning assembly without fail.

**Respect for Self**

- A. Come in proper school uniform. Boys to get a regular hair (crew) cut. In case of girls, hair must be tied in a neat ponytail or a plait with BLUE rubber bands. No fancy accessories are allowed in the school.
- B. Flicks, puffs, highlighting and dyeing of hair and applying henna on hands are NOT allowed.
- C. Truancy is a punishable offence and may lead to severe action.

**Respect for others**

- A. Refrain from pushing, shoving, blocking walkways or causing disturbance.
- B. Refrain from making threats and harassing others.
- C. Resolve differences and conflicts in a peaceful manner. Fighting defined as physical and / or verbal abuse where all parties have contributed to conflict, others verbally or physically, is prohibited.
- D. Respect the possessions of others. Taking or using other's possessions without their knowledge is not allowed.
- E. Use appropriate language at school. Art of bullying, use of foul language and vulgar behavior will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- F. Be courteous, considerate and truthful when interacting with all administrators, teachers, non-teaching staff and other students.

**Do's**

1. Be regular in bringing and writing the school diary everyday.
2. Come to school well groomed and in a proper uniform with shoes well polished.
3. Be regular in attendance and never be late to school. Be on time, or you shall be sent back.
4. Attend Morning Assembly without fail.
5. Be fair and honest at work, Be nice to each other. Show good sportsman spirit.
6. Be courteous and respectful to parents, teachers and visitors.
7. Be kind to trees, flowers and animals.
8. Look after the property of your school. Help to keep it clean and tidy.
9. Keep your class clean and tidy. Throw waste paper wrapper, etc. into the waste paper basket.
10. Read the newspaper daily.
11. Turn off the tap after drinking water.
12. Switch off fans and lights when not in use.

**Don't**

1. Bring articles of value such as rings or pieces of jewellery to school. The school will not be held responsible for the loss of such articles.
2. Lend or borrow money or any precious articles.
3. Make loud noise or create confusion in the class room, school auditorium or elsewhere in the school building.
4. Miss school too often. 75% attendance is compulsory in an academic session.
5. The students who leave school before completing Senior Secondary, will not be awarded for their achievements.
6. Mobile phones, Ipads, Mp3, Cameras etc. are strictly prohibited.

**Note:**

1. The Photograph of a students will not be attested by the principal if it is not in proper school (Winter) uniform.
2. Wilful absenteeism in the secondary and senior secondary classes is extremely undesirable and strict action will be taken in this regard. Parents may be asked to accompany their ward the next day.
3. A sum of Rs. 200/- will be charged from the students who lose the 1-card.

## IMPORTANT

- If a student is found using unfair means in the cycle test/ exam etc. Zero will be awarded to him /her. The first time the child will not be allowed to take the retest of the same. He /she will be debarred from any recognition from the school authorities for that academic year.
- Any error if found in the report card should be brought to the notice of the class teacher along with the copy of the report card on the result day itself.
- Care should be taken that a child does not attend school when he/she is unwell. Further-more, he/she should avoid short leave/ half day leave during the session.
- School does not take any responsibility of any party/ celebration organized by parents/students to celebrate birthdays outside the school campus.
- Parents should respond positively to any phone call/ letter concerning absence of his/ her ward.
- Taking leave during working days is strongly discouraged, parents are responsible to make up for the loss of the studies, in case of leave taken. The school will expect these students to be at par with the class in every way and that will have to be ensured by the parents.

3. Disable unnecessary notifications.
4. Develop Coping Skills.
5. Spend some quality time with your ward and teach them that internet is not YOUR Family.

## ===== ECO FRIENDLY GOOD AND HEALTHY HABITS =====

- Bring home made tiffin neatly packed for your lunch in the school as nothing can replace your mother's care and concern.
- Take bath daily and brush your teeth twice a day. Wash your hands before and after the meals with soap. Rinse your mouth after every meal.
- Nails should be cleaned & clipped regularly.
- Shoes should be polished.
- Respect your parents, teachers and elders by proper salutation and greetings.
- Learn to say 'Sorry' & 'Thank you' for the smallest of mistakes and favours respectively. Use of 'Please' makes you polite.
- Use handkerchief of your own.
- Do not slouch or stoop while walking/reading/writing or eating at the desk/table. Good posture is important for your health.
- Boys hair cut should be short & proper and girls hair should be properly tied.
- Avoid excessive intake of junk food.
- Switch off light, fan, T.V., Radio etc. when not in use.
- Do not waste water, turn off tap when not in use.
- Don't bang doors & don't litter.
